Our topic is Minibeasts. This week our literacy story is 'Pirates Love underpants' Ask your child what was their favourite part of the story and why? Encourage your child to use full sentences.

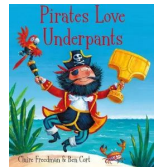
Our oracy sentence stems are below:

For example:

"I like this story...because.."

"In the beginning of the story..."

"My favourite character is...because..."



In maths, encourage your child to practise simple addition and subtraction using everyday objects. For example:

- Count out 10 toys and ask, "If I take away 3, how many are left?"
 - Use snacks, blocks, or coins to solve simple number problems.
- Play number games such as "I have 5 apples and get 2 more. How many do I have altogether?"
 - Encourage your child to explain how they worked out the answer.
